Boudica, Britain's Rebellious Queen By Paddy Lambert (Oxford Archaeology)

Paddy will give an insight into Boudica, the warrior queen of the Iceni tribe. Following the death of her husband, King Prasutagus, the Romans annexed his kingdom, brutally mistreating Boudica and her daughters. In response she led a fierce revolt against the invaders in around 60-61 AD. Her forces destroyed Roman settlements, including London.

Despite early successes, the rebellion was eventually crushed but her legacy lives on as a symbol of resistance and the struggle for freedom against oppression.
